Nursery	Girls, boys and families	 To understand there should be no constraints for children, purely based on whether they are boys or girls.

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

CIRCLE THE PARTS THAT ARE THE SAME ON BOTH BOYS AND GIRLS





Year 1	Keeping privates private	 Identify parts of the body that are private. Describe ways in which private parts can be kept private. Identify people they can talk to about their private parts.








Year 2	My body, your body	 Identify which parts of the human body are private. Referred to as 'boys' private parts' and 'girls' private parts'. Understand that humans mostly have the same body parts but that they can look different from person to person.



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


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Year	Торіс	Learning objectives
Year 4	All change	 Identify parts of the body that males and females have in common and those that are different. Know the correct terminology for their genitalia. Understand and explain why puberty happens.



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To be labelled with:


- Female: vulva, (see note, below*), vagina, ovaries, eggs, womb, clitoris, labia, breasts
- Male: penis, testicles, sperm, pubic hair

Year 4	My Changing Body	 Recognise that babies come from the joining of an egg and sperm. Explain what happens when an egg doesn't meet a sperm. Understand that for girls, periods are a normal part of puberty.











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Year	Торіс	Learning objectives
Year 6	Pressure online	 Understand the risks of sharing images online and how these are hard to control, once shared. Understand that people can feel pressured to behave in a certain way because of the influence of the peer group. Understand the norms of risk-taking behaviour and that these are usually lower than people believe them to be.
